

Your pup has been given his/her first puppy vaccinations, has been wormed regularly and the dates of these treatments have been recorded in your Pet Health Record. Take your pup to the vet of your choice within forty-eight (48) hours for examination. If the puppy should arrive on a weekend or holiday you have an additional twenty-four (24) hours.

This puppy is guaranteed for one year against fatal and life altering congenital disease which may adversely affect the health of the animal. This includes but is not limited to heart, pancreas and liver problems. If the pup is found at this time to have a life threatening illness or congenital defect, the breeder must be contacted and legal proof from a licensed veterinarian stating the defect must be emailed to the breeder (houseofjob@gmail.com) within three (3) days. We reserve the right to have the diagnosis verified by a veterinarian of our choice at your expense; however, most of the time your vet's diagnosis will be satisfactory. Please keep copies of all dog food receipts and vet bills for breeder to reference in order to qualify for replacement puppy. Once verified, the puppy will be replaced with another comparable puppy as soon as one is available. Buyer is responsible for transportation costs to and from the seller on a replacement puppy.

The puppy may not be put to sleep due to congenital defect or for any other reason beyond being in unbearable pain. If the dog dies within the one year time frame, the buyer pays to have a necropsy done by a state or university pathologist to decipher the problem. If the puppy was born with a fatal illness, we will replace the puppy with another comparable puppy within a reasonable amount of time.

Your puppy has a one (1) year genetic health guarantee. This guarantee does not cover certain issues that are common for a Great Dane. For example; torsion of the stomach (bloat), haw eyes, entropion, uneven bites, cherry eye, undescended testicles, demodex mange, inguinal or umbilical hernias, fleas, ticks or ear mite, Coccidian and Kennel Cough (common in puppies that are shipped; often caused by bacteria). Full recovery is expected from Kennel Cough.

Buyer is responsible for regular veterinary care, including the remainder of the initial series of puppy vaccinations, rabies vaccinations and periodic worming necessary to maintain the health of the puppy. The Buyer shall maintain the puppy in good condition, including adherence to a regular immunization schedule, heartworm preventative, appropriate high quality diet, and a clean & safe environment.

This puppy is bred to be a companion animal and an affectionate family member. Although your puppy may be capable of excellence in the show ring, no warranty is provided by the seller as to its fitness for any specific purpose. In the event that the buyer cannot care for the puppy, it is required that the buyer return the puppy to the seller at no expense to the seller. If the puppy has been registered, buyer must transfer full-ownership to the seller. No money shall be refunded. At no time is seller responsible for any veterinary bills after the dog is purchased.

We will not be responsible for any illness or injury that may be caused by improper care or treatment by the buyer once the puppy leaves our care (including but not limited to hypoglycemia). Be aware that stress and change of dog food or water can cause upset tummies and even bloody stools in young puppies. Call us if this happens. We can help you control the symptoms without a costly vet visit.
